

CITY OF AUSTIN: GO PURPLE PROGRAM NEW WATER REUSE REQUIREMENTS FOR LARGE SCALE DEVELOPMENTS

As of April 1, 2024 Austin, Texas introduced a code change that will now require large scale developments to install reuse systems or connect to reclaimed water.

This will apply to commercial, multifamily or mixed-use projects that exceed 250,000 square feet. Whether it's one building or a combination on the same site plan that exceeds the threshold, the development will require reuse or connection to reclaimed water.






Onsite Water Reuse Systems (OWRS) will be required to collect AC condensation and rainwater, and are allowed to be used for irrigation, toilet flushing, and cooling towers. To help facilitate the implementation of OWRS, Austin Water offers several incentives as part of its Go Purple Program.

- OWRS Pilot Incentive Program Application AW pays up to \$500,000 per qualifying project
- **Expedited Building Plan Review Rebate Application –** AW pays up to \$36,000 per qualifying project
- PACE Financing Study AW assists applicants with documenting eligible water savings and project costs Greyter Water
